General Aircraft Notes

Please remember to only fuel to the tabs when fueling after your flight at SQL. If you need to put in an "odometer" setting when using the Chevron credit card just enter all zeros and just hit the "enter" key for vehicle input. Don't forget to write your name and member # on all fuel receipts.

If there are any off-field MX issues call Dave Colbert first.

Make sure Club aircraft are pushed all the way back against the rear wheel chocks with the nose wheel chock firmly pushed up against the front of the nose wheel. The spinner of 26F has been found just inches from the hangar door. Please be careful parking in the hangar.

Aircraft Rates (effective Dec 1, 2022) 26F is \$150/hr. and 86C is \$165/hr.

Please get Flt Manager approval for all overnight flights and leave itinerary form in Flt Manager's mailbox and email the itinerary to <u>Larry</u> <u>Miller, at N79148@gmail.com not less than</u> one week before your flight.

Please double-check that the door locks are, in fact, locked when leaving the hangers

Please continue wiping down surfaces inside the aircraft to keep us Covid free!
